HARE & HOUNDS CLASSIC VEHICLE CLUB LTD - INSTRUCTIONS FOR SHOWS & RUNS

1. All vehicles on runs, shows, events, etc., MUST be road legal.
2. When taking part in a run you MUST comply with ALL speed and road requirements.
3. H&HCVC does NOT accept any liability for any theft or damage whatsoever to ANY vehicles at shows, runs or any events. Whilst H& HCVC has public liability insurance this does NOT extend to vehicles and owners.
4. When attending a show, or following a run, you MUST be aware of, and take note of, the organisers conditions. Special note MUST be taken of emergency requirements.
5. If required at a show an entry or other pass MUST be displayed at ALL times.
6. The maximum speed at ALL shows is 5 mph. Pedestrians have right of way so great care MUST be taken. If you do not comply, you and your vehicle will be asked to leave.
7. You are more than welcome to display your engine, but the bonnet MUST have a secondary means of support.
8. All unattended vehicles must be parked in gear with the handbrake on.
9. Due notice MUST be taken of arrival and departure times as required by the organisers.
10. If you need to leave early for any reason you MUST have two H&H CVC marshalls and/or organiser's marshalls in attendance.
11. When attending ANY event where H&HCVC are involved it is deemed that you have read and accepted these instructions.
